



AMA Conference 2022 | 14-15 July 2022 Museum Development East Midlands Bursary Application Form

Museum Development East Midlands will provide 3 bursaries that cover the full cost of a ticket for the AMA Conference 2022.

These bursaries are available to those working for organisations across the cultural sector.

Applications are open to both AMA members and non-members, including those who can no longer afford to take part in AMA events due to Covid-19.

All applicants must be individuals who work or volunteer at an Accredited Museum in the East Midlands, your museum must have submitted their <u>Organisational Health Check</u> at the time of application, and must meet **one or more** of the following criteria.

Criteria:

- Individual from a culturally and/or ethnically diverse background (including, but not limited to, the 9 protected characteristics identified by the Equality Act 2010: age, disability, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity, race, religion or belief, sex, and sexual orientation)
- Individual working in a geographical area with high levels of deprivation (by this we mean due to rural isolation or low socio-economic communities for example)
- Individual representing a diverse-led organisation (by this we mean an organisation which is led by and supports people from specific protected characteristic groups)

Please note:

- We will only award one bursary per organisation
- In the event of us receiving a greater number of applications than places available, Arts Council England will make a comparative assessment of all applications received to assess their fit with published priorities.
- Recipients of the bursaries will be asked to provide informal feedback on their experience at AMA Conference 2022 to Museum Development East Midlands.
- The AMA will request successful applicants to provide feedback, that may be used for marketing purposes, on their experience AMA Conference 2022.
